8:30 AM Opening Session – A Matter of the Heart

Psalm 139:23 reads: "Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my concerns." This verse reminds us God fully knows and sees our hearts. However, this requires we first examine our own hearts and thoughts toward today's children. Recent findings have also indicated that physical stability is an important foundation for preventing feelings of anxiety. This session will explore the connection between the brain and the body and identify ways to support this connection.

What is childhood trauma and its effects on children? This session will create an awareness of the effects of childhood trauma and identify a trauma-sensitive classroom that offers the compassion, trust, and warmth of Christ.
