

Visa on Arrival Checklist

To enter Indonesia, there are 3 ways to get a Visa, **Visa on Arrival (VoA)** online and in-person and an **E-Visa**. Each traveler must be a citizen from the list of pre-approved countries eligible for VoA ([details on page 7](#)). If your country is **NOT** listed, [please see page 8 for a-Visa](#).

To apply for the online Visa on Arrival which is **valid for up to 30 days**, please follow the directions below.

1. Apply for the online B213 30-day Visa on Arrival (e-VoA) through:
www.molina.imigrasi.go.id

- [] **Passport**
A valid passport with more than 6 months validity.
- [] **Photo ID**
- [] **A valid Mastercard, Visa, or JCB Credit Card**
- [] **Round-Trip Flight Ticket**
A proof of a return trip out of Indonesia.

Make sure you've **provided the correct document before the payment** because if it's **denied**, the Immigration **can't refund your payments**. You can create a new e-VoA request when you realized some of the document or information requires correction. Once your request is done, you can **download your e-VoA** via the "Application" tab.

Note:

The e-VoA fee is **IDR 500,000** or **USD \$35**. Please note that every payment will be done via **Debit/Credit Card**.

You can **apply for e-VoA 14 days before your travel**. You're advised to create an e-VoA request **at least 48 hours before your departure**.

The **validity period** of your e-VoA **begins from the date specified in your application**. You can **enter Indonesia on any date within this period**. Remember, e-VoA is only for a **single entry**.



2. Applying for the in-person VoA:

Once you've **arrived** in Indonesia at the **Immigration Counter**, please be prepared to **pay the VoA fee of IDR 500,000 or USD \$35** (per May 2022) **in cash** and **provide the following documents**.

[] **Passport**

A valid passport with more than 6 months validity.

[] **Round-Trip Flight Ticket**

A proof of a return trip out of Indonesia.

[] **Travel or Health Insurance**

Insurance that covers your medical bills during your travel.

[] **Accommodation Booking Confirmation
or Invitation Letter**

Know your address information while you are staying in Indonesia.

Note:

Once you have paid for the VoA, keep the payment receipt and show it at the Immigration counter later.

E-Visa Instructions

For countries NOT listed on document above

3. Applying for an E-Visa which is valid for up to 30 days.

Please visit this website to begin the visa application process:

To change the site to **English**, click on the button that says “**Bahasa Inggris**” and click on “**more information**” for steps and documentation to complete your visa application.

Please apply early as the visa can take up to **3-5 business days** to be sent to your email.

All of the information needed to apply for the E-Visa can be found under the “more information” tab on the visa website.

Make sure you've **provided the correct document before the payment** because if it's **denied**, the Immigration **can't refund your payments**. You can create a new e-Visa request when you realized some of the document or information requires correction.

Note:

The e-Visa fee is **IDR 1,500,000** or **USD \$95-\$100**. Please note that every payment will be done via **Debit/Credit Card**.

You can also **ignore** the COVID-19 vaccination/proof of vaccination requirements. These are no longer required for travel to Indonesia.

The **validity period** of your e-Visa **begins from the date specified in your application**. You can **enter Indonesia on any date within this period**. Remember, the e-Visa is only for a **single entry**.
