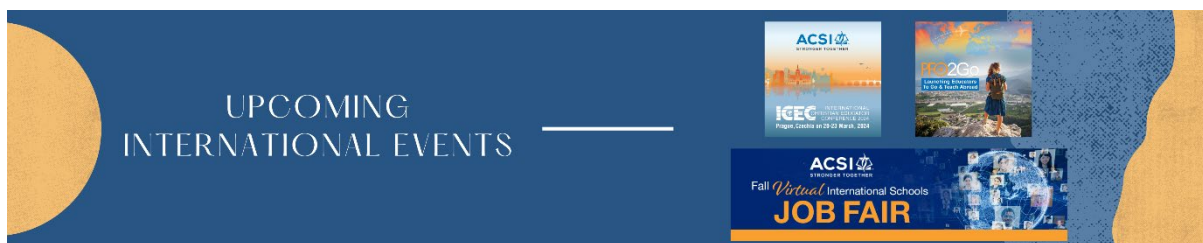

Perspective Continued

A dear friend of mine, and a friend to all of us at ACSI, is fighting cancer now. Dr. Stephen Reel, formerly VP USA and Acting CEO at ACSI, who now serves as HOS at Mitchell Road Christian Academy in Greenville (SC), was recently diagnosed with acute lymphoblastic leukemia (ALL). He was in the hospital up until recently and is now receiving out-patient treatments at home. Stephen has always modeled to me—and to many—what it means to live an authentic, faith-filled life, and he continues to be a godly example even amid many tests and difficult treatments for this terrible disease. He texted me this the other day:

A verse the Lord gave us this morning has been inspirational:

Keep me safe, O God, for I have come to you for refuge. I said to the Lord, "You are my Master! Every good thing I have comes from you." I will bless the Lord who guides me; even at night my heart instructs me. I know the Lord is always with me. I will not be shaken, for He is right beside me. No wonder my heart is glad, and I rejoice. My body rests in safety. You will show me the way of life, granting me the joy of your presence and the pleasures of living with you forever.
—Psalm 16:1-2, 7-9, 11 NLT

I especially love the words, "He is right beside me." What more could we want?

While he admits to having had some down moments along the way (and who wouldn't, right?), what Stephen understands at his core—and it's something we should all more fully embrace as we look to 2024—is that biblical perspective moves us from how we're feeling to what we know to be true! Focusing on the truth of God's Word—and His faithfulness in our lives—reminds us we are not alone. Perspective. That He is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble (Psalm 46:1). Perspective. And His grace is sufficient for you ... for His power is made perfect in weakness (2 Cor. 12:9). Perspective. Amen?

The hard truth is that "Happy New Year" is a relative term, isn't it? It's all about our perspective. So, whether you, a loved one, or a colleague is dealing with something now, there is a strong likelihood that you will have to face some additional, yet unknown, challenges in 2024.

The good news? "Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight" (Hebrews 4:13). There isn't a day or a tear that God doesn't know about. He sees whatever we're going through ... and He knows. God's Word also reassures us the Lord hears His people when they call to Him for help (Psalm 34:17). God knows every prayer spoken, and He hears the cries of our hearts. Our prayer for you as you begin 2024: "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope" (Romans 15:13). Perspective.

Please lift our brother and sister, Stephen and Melanie Reel, in prayer before Him in the coming days and weeks.
