

It is DoD's policy that community-based child care providers receiving fee assistance meet State licensing regulations and requirements; adhere to early learning standards by a DoD approved national accrediting organization; and be inspected by an outside agency once a year. Providers participating in their state's Quality Improvement program may also qualify, if they are accredited by a recognized agency or have a quality level of three of higher.

If an accrediting agency's early learning standards have not been reviewed by DoD, a thorough evaluation will be conducted by the Office of Military Family Readiness Policy for approval. Therefore, unlicensed community-based providers will not be considered (e.g., Association of Christian School International ACSI have faith-based programs that voluntarily comply with state licensing requirements) for the fee assistance program.
