



North American Coalition for Christian Admissions Professionals (NACCAP)

If an individual completes all six modules outlined by NACCAP and obtains NACCAP Certification, ACSI will allow that certification to replace the 15 semester hours of college credit in school counseling required for the Professional Level School Counselor certificate (meeting and exceeding the number of hours in school counseling required for the Standard Level certificate). The applicant would still have to meet all other certification requirements, including the 21 semester hours of college credit in general counseling or related field. A Temporary Level certificate, which is renewable, will be issued until the applicant completes all the certification requirements for the Standard Level.

Completion of module 1 will fulfill the first half of ACSI's Christian Philosophy of Education (CPoE) checklist, as well as the "Write" section under part two of the checklist. Please submit the signed checklist with the certification application.
